Reception Honoring the Top Ten Conservative Legislators in Texas

Heritage Alliance and Heritage Alliance PAC (Dallas-based) sponsored The Power of One Dessert Reception honoring the ten most conservative legislators in Texas. The annual fundraiser honored legislators dedicated to upholding traditional values in government. The event also emphasized the power of one voice and one vote making a difference in our state. The reception was held on Tuesday, October 3rd at Royal Oaks Country Club in Dallas.

Heritage Alliance awarded ten state legislators with the 2005 Conservative Texas Leader Award. Heritage Alliance evaluates each legislator's voting record and gives a score based on how conservatively he or she voted. Ten of the 150 Texas representatives scored a 90% or higher during the last regular session. No Texas senator received a 90% or higher score.

The ten state representatives who received the award were: Leo Berman of Tyler, Linda Harper-Brown of Irving, Charlie Howard of Sugar Land, Jim Jackson of Carrollton, Bill Keffer of Dallas, Jodie Laubenberg of Rockwall, Jerry Madden of Plano, Ken Paxton, Jr. of McKinney, Robert Talton of Pasadena, and Carl Isett of Lubbock. (Rep. Talton attended the program but left early and is not pictured. Two other honored representatives not pictured are Rep. Isett of Lubbock who was unable to attend due to military duty in Iraq, and Rep. Madden who was unable to attend because of family illness.)

"Our twenty one years of experience evaluating legislation has taught us that it takes courage to stand on principle," commented Clare Jones, Vice President of Heritage Alliance.
